Starting with the white, the 2015 Cotes du Roussillon les Orris Blanc is a terrific blend of 65% Grenache Blanc and 35% Roussanne that will see eight months in 25% new oak barrels. Its medium-gold color is followed by classy notes of spiced apples, citrus and brioche; on the palate, it's medium-bodied, nicely balanced and concentrated, with lots of salty minerality emerging on the finish. I suspect it will put on a touch of weight once bottled and drink nicely for 4-5 years. This is a serious, food friendly white.

Located just outside the village of Corneilla-de-la-Rivière, Domaine Boucabeille is run today by the young Jean Boucabeille and covers 28 hectare of vines planted mostly on the steep, schist, south-facing hillsides of the Forca Real Mountain. The farming here is all organic and the winemaking is as non-intrusive as possible. These are high quality wines.
